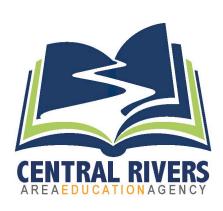

Dr. Mary Stevens presented information regarding the development of a MTSS framework for supporting social, emotional, behavioral and mental health needs of students. The goal is to center strong leadership with the following foundational themes: empathetic learning environments, access resources through community partnerships, focus on learner evidence, and promote youth engagement in school and community. Dr. Stevens gave credit to Amy Moine, Director of Professional Learning for her work on helping develop the professional learning opportunities for MTSS.
