Paper Prices Increase

If you've had to buy paper recently, you may have noticed having to pay more. Over the past 18 months, paper prices have significantly increased. Prices for paper and paper products are up anywhere from 7-20 percent across the board. Why?

Increased tariffs on offshore paper have limited supply. Some manufacturers have shut down or permanently closed their mills, unable to continue production as a result of increased transportation and raw material (pulp) costs. Tighter margins are being seen as a result of an unstable market and, finally, a decrease in usage has slowed down mass production in efforts of keeping supply and demand steady.

AEA Purchasing, a cooperative purchasing service of lowa's AEAs, bids cut paper twice a year and has seen the variance between bidders get smaller and smaller. Today, the standard case of white, 8.5 x 11 cut paper is around \$32/case with the average "street price" (non-contract) ranging anywhere from \$35-\$59.
