Critical Department of Education due dates - Each month's important deadlines are posted at bit.ly/dedeadlines.

Welcome back to school! Once everyone catches their breath, don't forget to reach out to your legislators to advocate on behalf of your schools and invite them into your buildings. Thank them for the passage of SAVE and the transportation and per-pupil equity efforts. Point out the great work that is underway, but also let them know where your critical issues are and the need for more adequate funding and overall support for public education. It's important to let them know what you could do for students with increased resources!

Executive Leaders – Dates for the 2019-20 Executive Leaders events are set. The group will meet Sept. 19-20 and Jan. 16-17, continuing the Thursday evening, Friday morning format. Meetings will be held at the FFA Enrichment Center in Ankeny. The September meeting will feature student mental health resources, table conversations about board-superintendent relations, legislative advocacy, a progress update on new standards for lowa school leaders, and conversations among new and veteran superintendents. Public's Attitude Toward Public Schools - PDK International released its 51st annual poll August 5. For the first time since 2000 public school teachers were included, adding their voices to those of parents and the general public on crucial issues in public education. The study covered issues including school discipline; state-issued school report cards and other means of assessing school quality; school funding; civics, values, and religious studies in the curriculum; and attitudes toward workforce development classes.
