2020 Legislative Session - The legislative priorities have been finalized by the SAI Legislative Committee, and approved by the Rep Council. As we head into 2020 and the upcoming session, visit with your local legislators about public education and remind them that lowans have always been extremely proud of our schools and the quality education provided students. Legislators' actions should reflect our lowa values during the upcoming session!

Executive Leaders - The next Executive Leaders meeting is Jan. 16-17 on Thursday evening and Friday morning at the FFA Enrichment Center in Ankeny. Thursday attendees will have the opportunity to review a website drafted by Evan Abbey, AEA PD Online director, that will be a one-stop informational outlet for school mental health services in Iowa. Participants will be able to provide feedback and input prior to the site going live sometime this spring. DE representatives will talk about the new SEL competencies and how they will serve as a guide for districts. Friday morning, attendees will continue learning about the new leadership standards.
