

Quorum for Board Meetings

Action by the board regarding the affairs of the agency may be taken only when a quorum, a majority of the board members, are in attendance at the board meeting. While in person participation is encouraged, board members may attend meetings either in person or electronically provided each member can hear and be heard in real time by all members present and the public. A majority vote of those present shall be necessary and sufficient for a decision on a motion, unless the vote of a greater number shall be required by law. The adjournment of a meeting may be executed without a quorum.
