(4th-12th)

Single sign-on and single search feature to access a variety of content in multiple formats. Please contact your AEA Librarian or School Librarian for login access to Educator or Student accounts.

- Text to Speech
- Varying reading levels

- Translation - also read aloud in native female and male voices
- Read aloud

A multimedia collection of video clips, images, audio content, newsreels, interactives, printables, maps and flags that can be filtered by grade level.

Collection of popular fiction and nonfiction eBooks and audiobooks to support independent reading, as well as enhance classroom learning experiences. (Unique logins for each building and user.) Google and O365 integration options are available.

Combines Scholastic True Books ebooks content with reading supports and a deep and diverse collection of related videos, images, web links, and text.
