

Occupational Exposure to Bloodborne Pathogens

It shall be the responsibility of the Administrator or designee to write an exposure control plan to eliminate or minimize Agency occupational exposure to bloodborne pathogens. The plan for designated employees shall include, but not be limited to, scope and application, definitions, exposure control, methods of compliance, Hepatitis B vaccination, and post exposure evaluation and follow-up, communication of hazards to employees, and recordkeeping (*See AEA Exposure Control Plan for Bloodborne Pathogens on file in the Human Resources Office or on the AEA staff portal*).

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
