Surrogate Parent

The AEA shall appoint a surrogate parent to protect the rights of an individual in the decisionmaking process for special education services whenever the AEA documents that no parent can be identified, the AEA cannot discover the whereabouts of a parent after reasonable efforts, the individual is a ward of the state, or the individual is an unaccompanied homeless youth and is known to be or is suspected of being an individual with disabilities.
