We are rebranding our Mentoring and Induction Program for the 2023-2024 School Year, Creating an Engaging Environment to Empower Staff and Students! *This change will not only support mentors, but new hires and experienced teachers as well!*

Attendees are encouraged to attend both days, but will be able to select either day.

August 10th will focus on an introduction to Iowa's Four Approaches to developing the five CASEL SEL Competencies:

- Explicit SEL Instruction
- Teacher Instructional Practices
- Integration within Academic Curriculum Areas
- Organization, Culture, and Climate Strategies

We will be utilizing teaching strategies to accompany each of the approaches and competencies. This day will target all teachers (beginning and experienced),

instructional coaches, mentor coordinators, TLC members, and administrators.

August 11th will focus on building relationships between beginning teachers and their mentors as they develop the tools to implement an SEL-rich classroom. There will be the opportunity for mentors to enhance their coaching skills using the SEL Coaching Toolkit and the 4 C's of coaching, while beginning teachers dig into SEL practices to be established during the first weeks of school. The target audience is for beginning teachers and mentors, and anyone supporting beginning teachers including: instructional coaches, mentor coordinators and administrators.
